



Putting your ideas into action

- Consultation with halls and reserves to understand what they require to prepare halls and reserves for future emergency use;
 Linking hall and reserve committees with professional
- services to assist with funding applications to ready halls for use in future emergencies;
- Providing council with evidence of local support for better communication infrastructure, to assist in their applications to providers.

Future plans:

- Liasing with local CFA brigades and BRV to host preparedness workshops
 Providing CFAs with the results of our surveys to assist with their community engagement activities
